



## DRAFT SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT OBJECTIVES 2023-2024

### 1. OVERALL EFFECTIVENESS

**Objective: Data to show continued improvement in standards.**

- 1.1 Greater Depth Standard (GDS):** Improve opportunities for pupils to access and evidence GDS standard in foundation subjects
- 1.2 Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS):** Increase % of pupils on track for EXS and GDS by fully embedding No-Nonsense Grammar across the school.
- 1.3 Writing:** Increase % of pupils gaining EXS and GDS through the Imagination Firelighters approach to writing.
- 1.4 Yr1 Phonics:** Increase % of pupils passing the Yr1 phonics assessment to be at least in line with the National Average.
- 1.5 KS1 Spelling:** Improve standard of spelling in KS1 by linking phonics teaching to new Spelling Shed scheme.

### 2. QUALITY OF EDUCATION

**Objective: Raise standards through a skills based purposeful curriculum that develops the whole child**

- 2.1 Creativity Collaboratives:** Increase opportunities for teaching creatively in all subjects by sharing good practice already embedded in some areas.
- 2.2 Cornish Identity:** Improve awareness and appreciation of Cornwall and its language.
- 2.3 Primary Careers Project:** Increase opportunities for pupils to develop their future aspirations through the development and delivery of a 'My Future Matters' curriculum.

### 3. BEHAVIOUR AND ATTITUDES

**Objective: Maintain standards throughout a period of change**

- 3.1 Change:** Ensure pupils and staff are supported and well managed during a period of significant change.
- 3.2 Zones of Regulation:** Improve pupils' ability to regulate own behaviour using traffic light system.

### 4. PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

- 4.1 Equality and Diversity:** Ensure the curriculum clearly shows how it helps to reinforce pupil awareness and understanding of being a respectful and respected citizen.
- 4.2 Youth Speaks:** Increase opportunities for pupils to present and articulate their learning across all aspects of school.
- 4.3 School Council:** Raise profile of School Council by making links with local councilors.
- 4.4 'I Matter' Curriculum:** Raise profile of provision of Personal Development by creating a plan of coverage.

**Objective: Manage change effectively**

**5.1 School Growth:** Ensure the transition from a 6 to a 7class structure is effectively managed financially and smoothly.

**5.3 SEND:** Increase the accessibility of SEND resources for parents on the school website.
