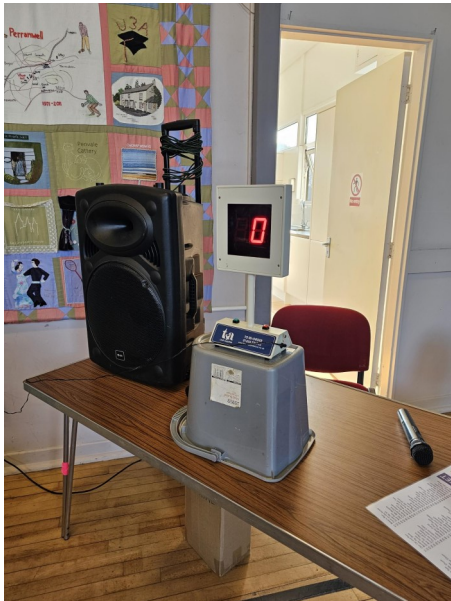

Chocolate Bingo



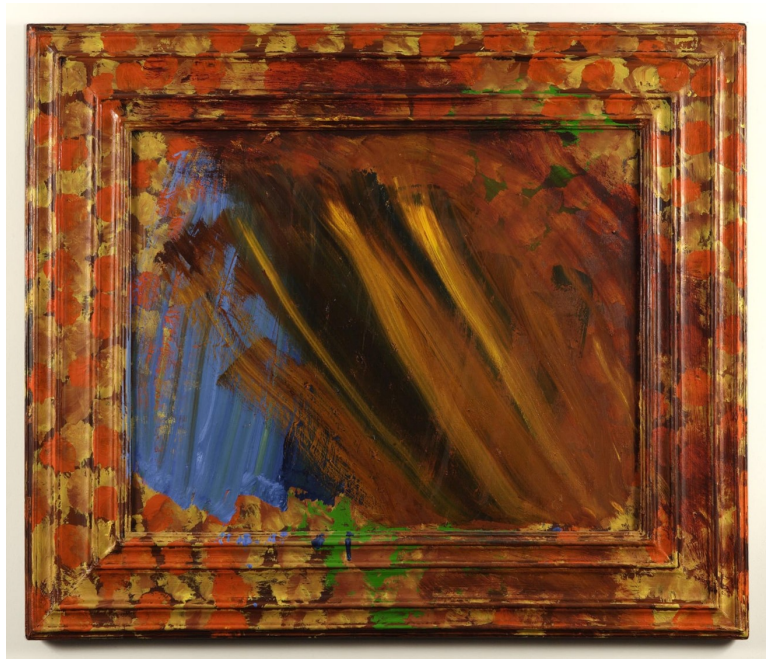

GETTING OUR EMOTIONS DOWN ON PAPER!

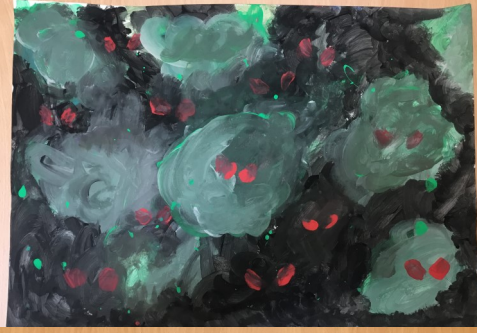
