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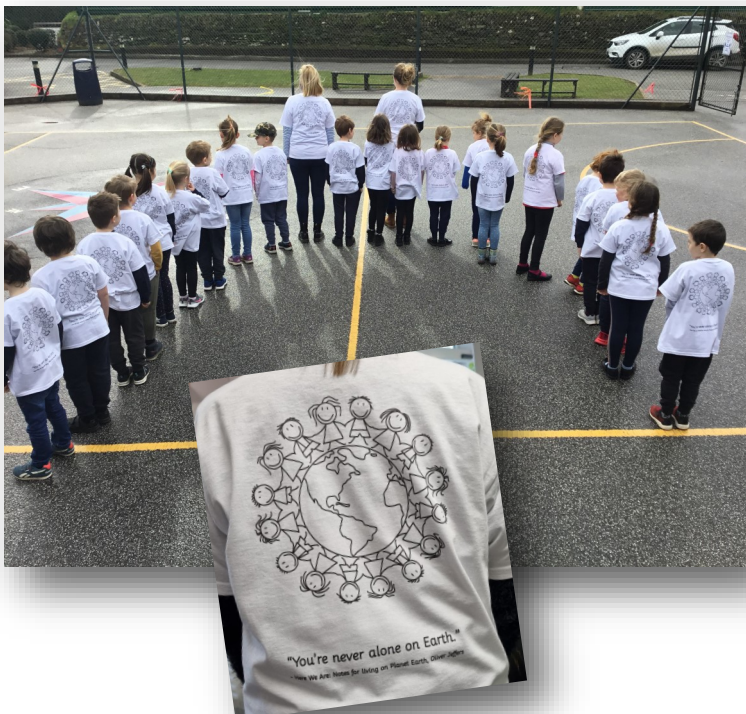
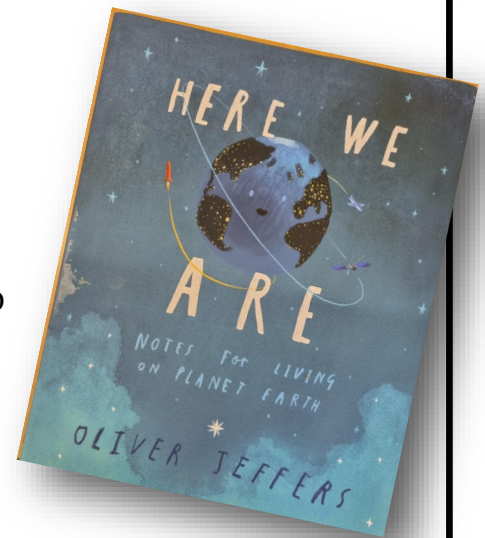
VERY MOMENT MATTERS!

"Even though it's closer to the Sun it's hotter because it's a gas house so it leaves." ~

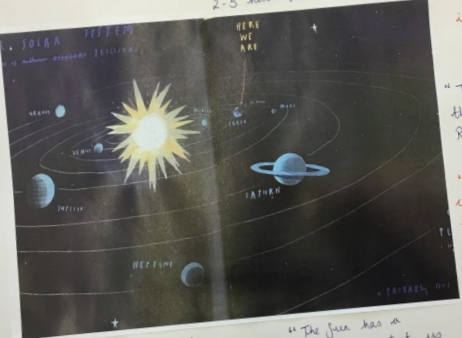
"The Sun has a thing to protect us because it's a really hot thing." ~ Arthur
