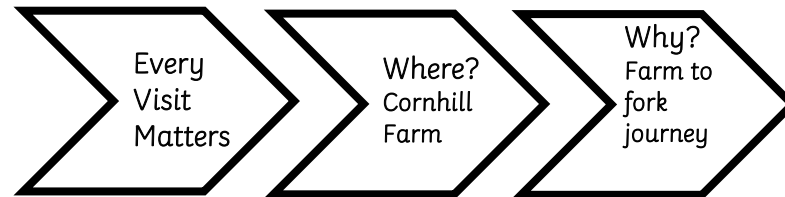
What changes have happened in farming in the UK?	What are the key similarities and differences between farms?	Where does our food come from?

Helpful Information

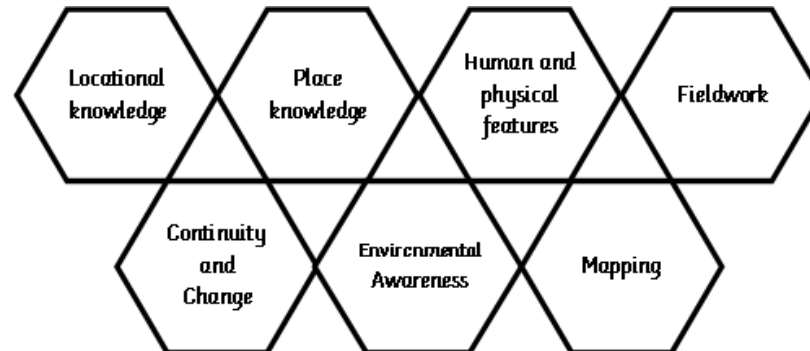
Sustainable	Looking after our planet so we don't run out of the things we need. Using things carefully and not causing harm.
Sustainability	Using things carefully so they don't run out or damage our planet, Making sure there's plenty of clean water, fresh air and nature left for animals, plants and people in the future.
Pastoral	A type of farming where farmers raise animals.
Arable	A type of farming where farmers grow crops.
Agriculture	The science and practice of growing crops and raising animals to give us the food, clothes and materials we need to survive.

Tier 1	crops, vegetables, farm

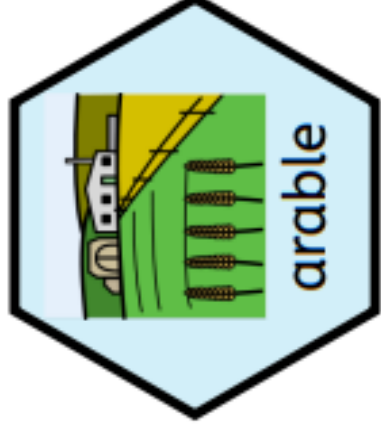
