As part of our Fabulous Friday activities I have arranged to take children in year 3 to Pelere Woods, this is a local woodland on the road to Mylor. There will be no cost involved for parents, we will be travelling in the school minibus. I can only take 14 children in the minibus and will therefore need offers of help with transport to and from Pelere Woods from 2 DBS checked parents, who will also need to complete a Cornwall Council volunteers driver form (available from the school office). You will be very welcome to stay for the afternoon if you wish.


