Some of these clubs have limited spaces to ensure the adult to pupil ratio is appropriate for the type of club taking place. The deadline for signing up will be Thursday of next week. We will then list on the newsletter next Friday, which children have managed to get a place in each of the clubs. Based on feedback from parents, we feel this is the fairest and most manageable way to organise the large number of clubs on offer. You will notice that some clubs will not start until later in the term due to availability of staff and seasonal changes. Fencing and multi skills will be on offer this year through Go Active, a company who provide fully qualified staff to run sports clubs in many of the primary schools in Cornwall. The cost for these clubs has been subsidised by the school using the government sports premium funding bringing the fee per session down to the £2 for multi skills and £3 for fencing. On January 23<sup>rd</sup>, Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will have the opportunity to have a free 30 minute fencing taster session run by Go Active. Due to forthcoming sports fixtures and music events some clubs have already started, such as basketball, cross county and recorder club. Adult choir will begin next week. New members are most welcome!

**COUNTY MUSIC FESTIVAL** – Last year our school was entered into several categories in the County Music Festival which takes place in March. The closing date for entries is fast approaching. Next week, for those children who have indicated that they are possibly interested in entering, I will be sending home details relating to this.
