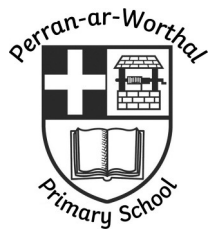

## **Cross country. 28/11/2025**



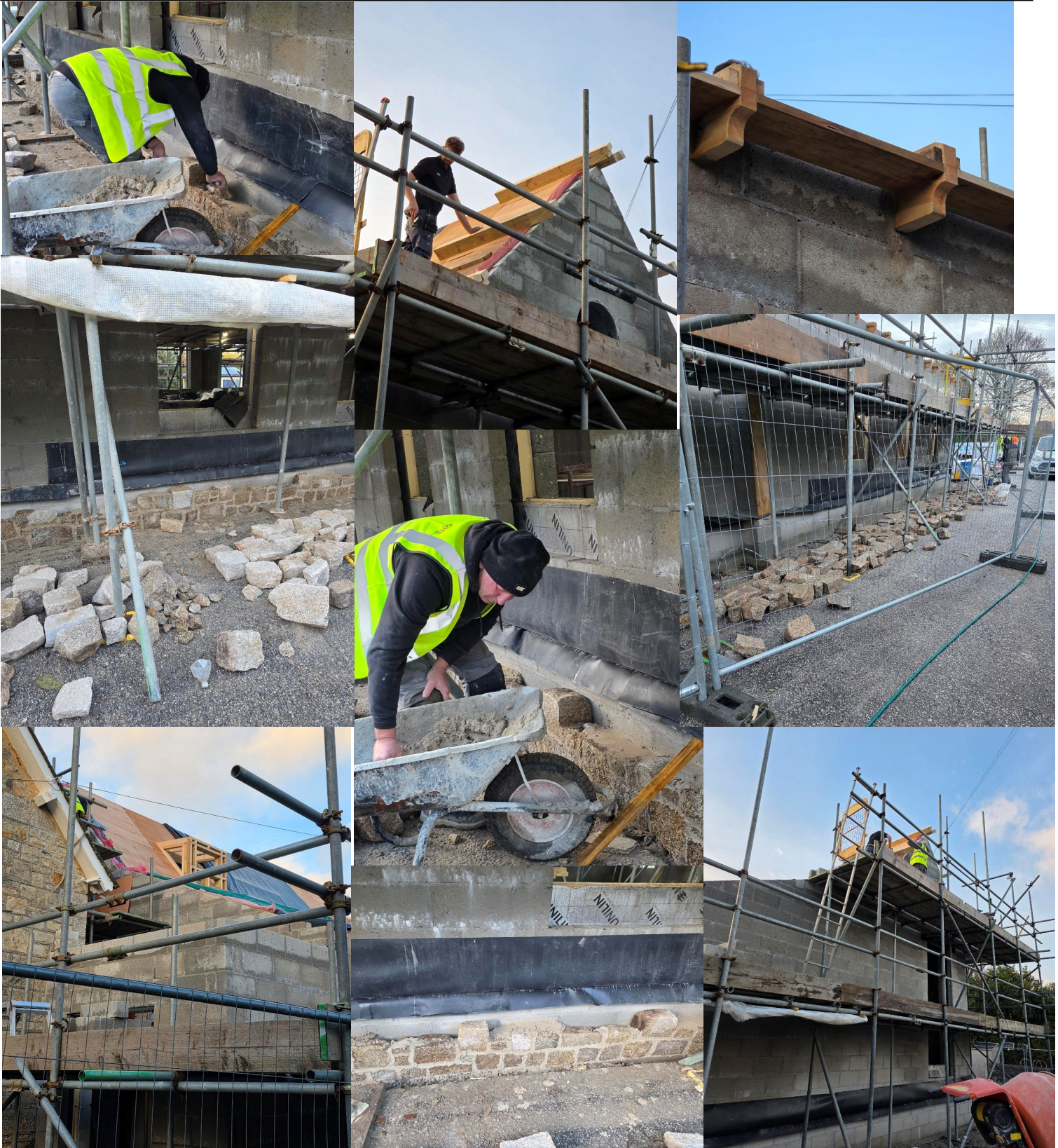
30 amazing runners
