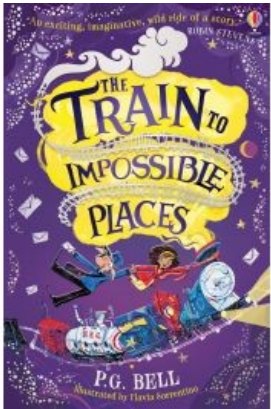

Key Success Criteria
