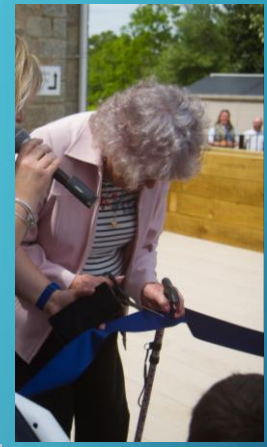
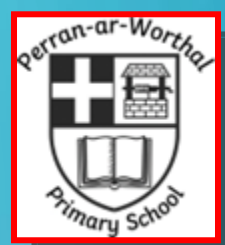


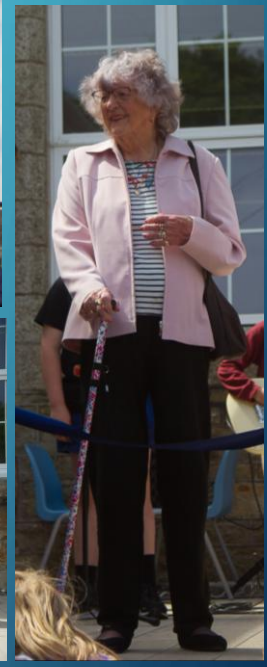

HOW MUCH?

If you ever wondered what it cost to build the original school in 1878, then below is a copy of the advert for tenders and an extract from a newspaper published on 7th December 1877 which gives a breakdown of the costs involved in building Perran-ar-Worthal Primary school.

**PERRANARWORTHAL
SCHOOL BOARD.**

To Builders and Contractors.

T E N D E R S

Are invited for the **ERECTION** and **COMPLETION** of **SCHOOLS**, with class-rooms and offices at **PERRANWELL** to accomodate 230 children respectively.

The plans and specification as approved by the Educational Department may be seen at the House of Mr. Joseph Row, Clerk to the Board, Perranwell, Perran-ar-worthal.

Sealed Endorsed Tenders, for the whole of the above work, to be sent to the Clerk of the Board, not later than the 23rd day November, 1877.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender.
