VISIT TO THE NATIONAL MARITIME MUSEUM

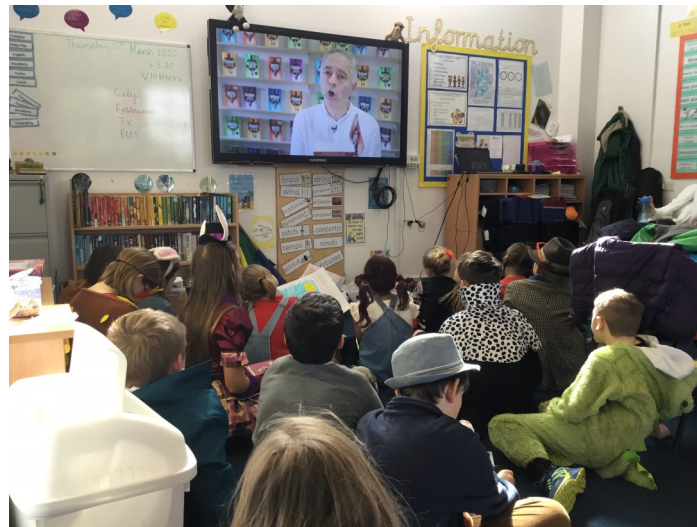
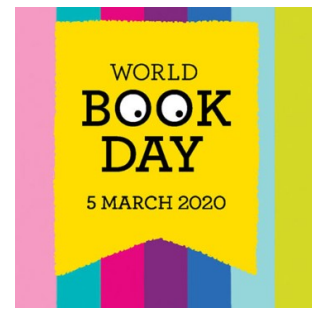
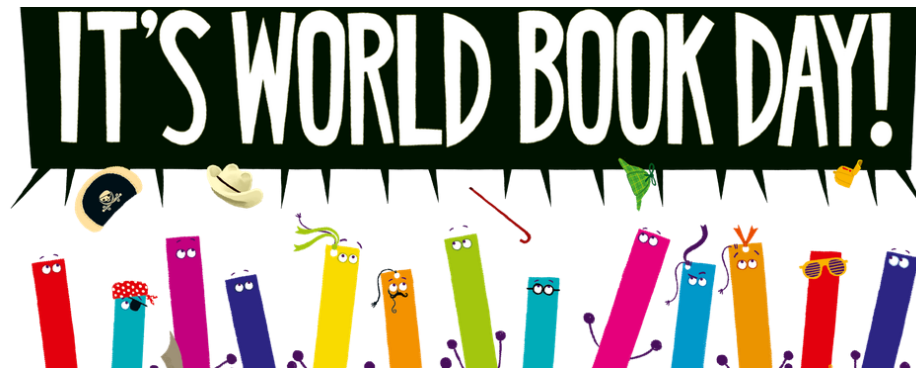
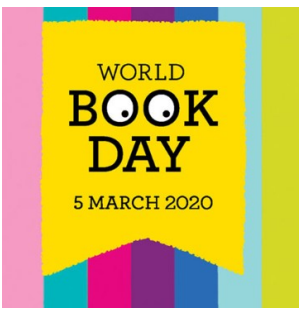

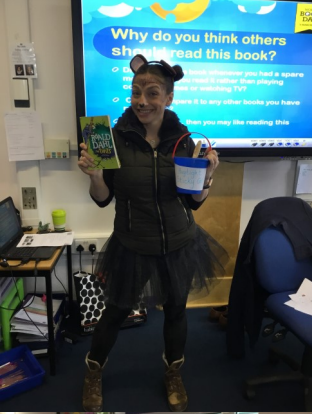
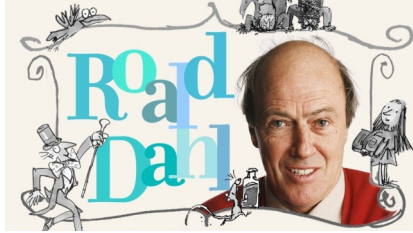
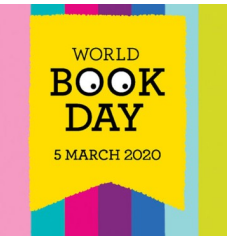
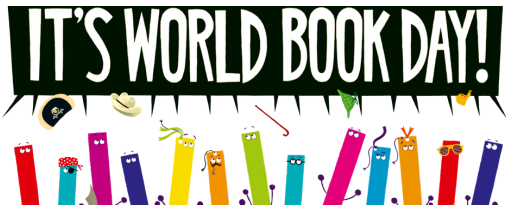
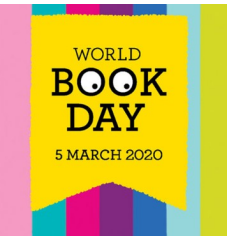
The children enjoyed the journey in the CHT funded coach.

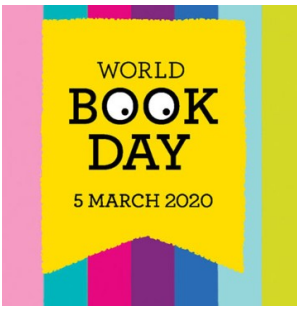

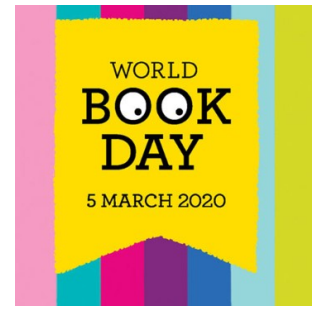
