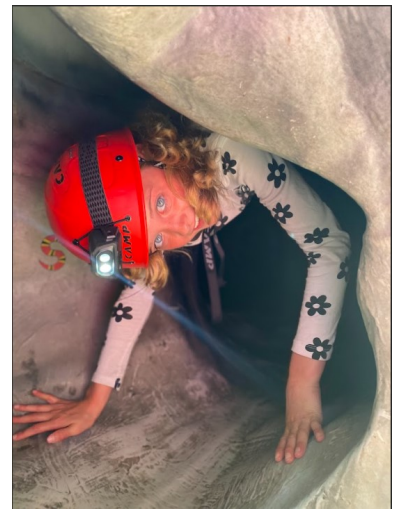

APPROPRIATE SCHOOL UNIFORM PLEASE: We have noticed a rise in KS2 pupils wearing inappropriate footwear during the week, nail polish, make-up, jewellery other than studs and unnatural hair colour. We would like to ask parents to support the school's expectations by ensuring your child attends school in the expected uniform. Please could we ask that pupils attend school with natural hair colour, no make-up or nail polish and wearing sensible school shoes during the week i.e. no heeled shoes or boots. Trainers can be worn on the day they have PE and on Fab Fridays.

The following accessories are acceptable:

Stud earrings, watches, sensible hair bands/clips/hair slides/hair grips/Alice bands. No more than one friendship wrist band.

Please do not wear the following to school:

Necklaces, bangles/bracelets, rings, hooped earrings, false nails, nail polish, make-up, heeled shoes/boots, unnatural hair colour.

Why is this so important?

We want our KS2 pupils to be role models for our younger children. We are also concerned about the risks relating to necklaces, bangles, rings and hooped earrings being worn in the playground when children are playing games.
