WHAT A FUNTASTIC NIGHT WE ALL HAD!

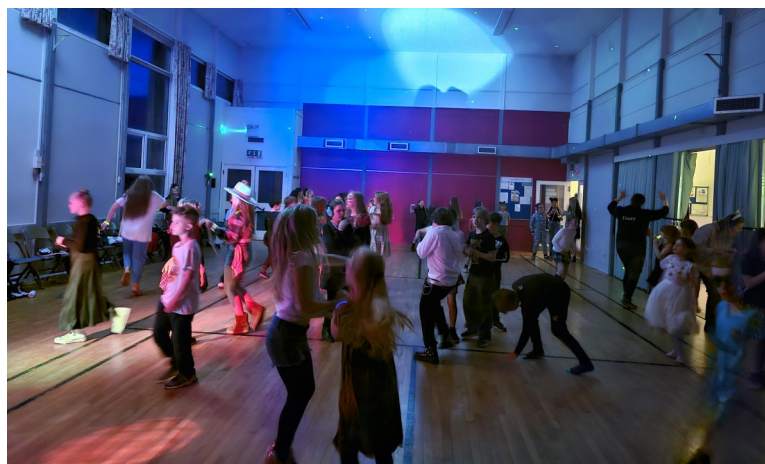
Scary costumes, lively music, plenty of space to throw some spooky shapes and a room filled with smiles, laughter and VERY excited children!
