

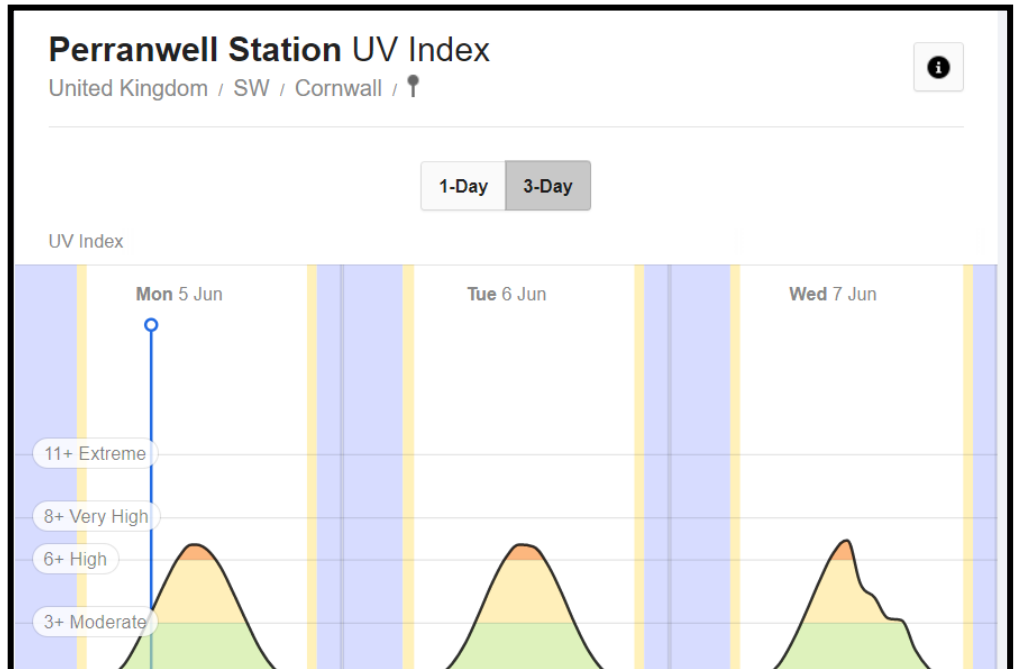

HOT WEATHER CAN BE DANGEROUS! The shelters are now up in the playground and we are ready for the summer. Please could we remind you to send your child in with a NAMED hat and to apply their sun cream before they arrive at school, which can then be re-applied later in the day. Staff can advise the children how to apply their sun cream but they are not permitted to apply it for them. Please could we ask that you encourage your child, as far as possible, to apply their own sun cream at home as this will help them re-apply it more effectively when they are at school. Please also remember to clearly NAME your child's sun cream bottle. These can then be kept in school in your child's tray or school bag. Children will not be able to share sun cream, unless they are siblings. Thank you for your support with this.

TAKING HOLIDAY DURING TERM TIME! Please could we ask that you avoid taking your child out of school during term time for holidays as this can impact on their learning and their progress. At the end of this term, parents will be issued with an annual attendance report that details authorised and unauthorised absences. We have no option but to record holidays as unauthorised on our electronic register unless there are extenuating circumstances. The school has a termly visit from the Local Authority Educational Welfare Officer (EWO) where a report of pupil absence and attendance has to be shared. Please be aware that a high level of absenteeism (below 90%) with any pupil will be questioned and a possible letter sent to the parent from the EWO. Thank you for your support with this.
