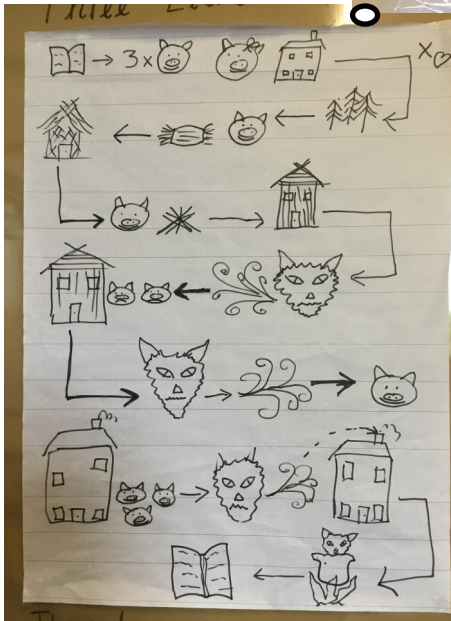

Using our fabulous shelter as an outdoor classroom for story telling and writing structure.

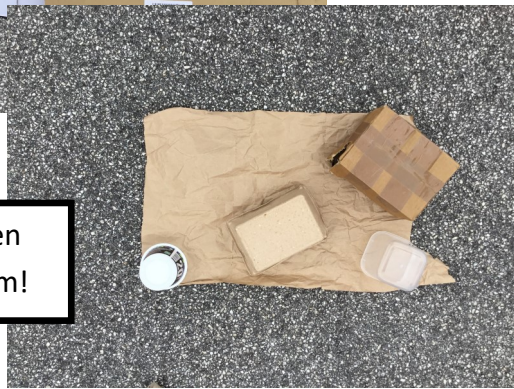


Creating building structures with junk modelling materials as part of our project on 'The Big Build' - linked to our story telling and writing about The Three Little Pigs.

And the builders have also been down in our Pufflings classroom!



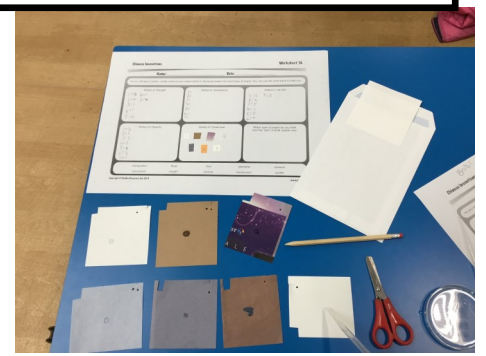
But there's always time to make a cup of tea and practice our fine and gross motor skills!
