PIANO LESSONS AT PERRAN-AR-WORTHAL SCHOOL WITH SAM SENDER!

I teach piano students at Perran-Ar-Worthal School as part of Cornwall Music Service Trust, and I'd be delighted to take on some new students. Many of the students have already seen me in assembly, as I led a demo on 3rd October in which four of my young piano students played beautifully. Jamie Pennington performed his very own composition, "The Tapping Climber", Leo Arthur played "This Old Man" wonderfully and Olivia Parker and Sophie Hobbs impressed us with their duet of "Mary Had a Little Lamb". The assembly audience also demonstrated their musical knowledge as they recognised my pieces including "Let It Go" (from Frozen), and they even correctly named "Hedwig's Theme" (the Harry Potter theme).

A little about myself - having studied BA Music at Falmouth University, I now live in Penryn where I'm part of the great local music scene. I play keyboards in weddings bands such as The Strutts, including gigs like Boardmasters Festival and the Pink Wig fundraiser in Falmouth. Having also been a Trustee of a national co-operative children's charity, I've seen how a supportive, inclusive culture can empower young people. In my lessons I aim to encourage creativity, improvisation and self-expression, and my proudest moments as a teacher have been when students have found their unique, personal voice as a musician. It's a pleasure for me to be able to share my passion.

I always recommend 30 minute one-to-one lessons as standard, either weekly or fortnightly. These cost £22.50 per lesson. Some students do qualify for fee reductions as follows. The fee is reduced to £11.25 fortnightly if you are eligible for means-tested Free School Meals, or alternatively there are subsidies relating to PIP/DLA, being in care and the Armed Forces. There's also a separate subsidy for students with certain SEN which can be combined 'on top'. For example, if you are eligible for means-tested Free School Meals and also have relevant SEN, a fortnightly 30 minute one-to-one lesson can be fully funded.
