

THE PLAN

- 3. What forces act on a car as it rolls down a hill?


















ROBINS GO BARE FOOT IN THE WILD! As part of the Wildlife Trusts activity 'I'm doing 30 Days Wild', our Robins have been making time for nature. The concept is simple: complete a Random Act of Wildness each day for 30 days. This can be anything from eating breakfast outside and listening to birdsong to planting wildflowers for a passing butterfly. The act doesn't have to be huge or difficult, it just has to be wild! Each Friday our Robins have been doing a range of outdoor wild activities to help make up their 30 days and they have been having a wonderful time enjoying the world around them.



ROBINS GET CREATIVE WITH MIXED MEDIA! Robins have been learning about African Kente cloth as part of their Art studies and have created their own mixed media paper versions using wooden blocks wrapped with string for printing with paint, and oil pastels to create an alternative pattern which they then wove together.
