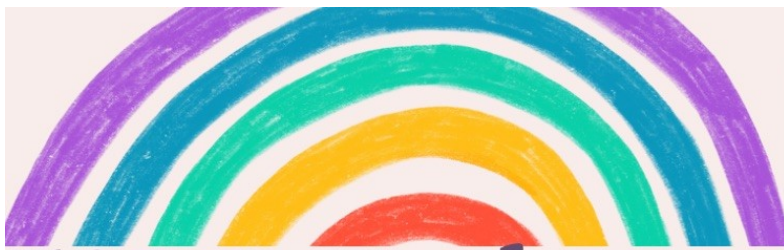
After unfortunate circumstances prevented us from competing in the first hockey matches, our hockey squad played brilliantly last week, winning against Penryn 3-1.
