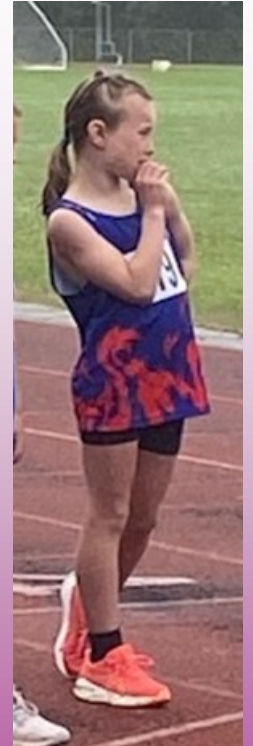


Cornwall Primary Schools Athletics Championships 2026
