Message to parents from Music Cornwall

AN IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING CORNWALL MUSIC SERVICE (MUSIC CORNWALL)

Dear valued supporter,

You are probably aware that Cornwall Council has made the decision to cut all funding support to Music Cornwall and therefore the nationally acclaimed, award-winning service that has served the young people of Cornwall for the last half century will close from the end of this term. Like many of us, you may have been deeply concerned about the future of the music service.

We are delighted to be writing to inform you that plans to create a new, independent service (established as a charitable trust) are well under way. The new service will operate under the name **Cornwall Music Service Trust (CMST)**. CMST aims to establish itself as Cornwall's largest provider of professional music tuition. It will have access to all current subsidies. The business model will be financially sustainable and will safeguard longevity for Cornish music education well into the future.

CMST will be managed by a small team of highly experienced music educators and it will be governed by a newly appointed board of trustees. It will also draw on a panel of advisers and will work in partnership with other organisations. All **CMST** staff will continue to receive up-to-date safeguarding training, CPD, DBS checks and Quality Assurance monitoring and mentoring programmes.

Our aim throughout has been driven by a singular, clear objective:

To continue to protect access to, and provision of, the highest quality standards of inspirational music education and breadth of opportunity for all Cornish school children and young people.
