Tier 3	tectonic plates, outcrop, ridge, treeline, snow line, crust, magma, fault lines, plateau, erosion, fault block, volcanic, fold, dome, constructive, destructive
Tier 2	summit, foot, slope, mountain range, lava, climate, weather, tourism, contour rings, peak
Tier 1	higher ground, map, mountain, atlas, country, location, risk, leisure,
