


Why this?

The Year 1s learn about making friends, being friends and being safe in their Jigsaw lessons.




Why this?

The Year 1s learn about being special, unique and inclusive in their Jigsaw lessons.




Why this?

The Year 1s study Africa as part of their Sensational Safari topic work.




Why this?

The Year 1s learn about achieving together and overcoming obstacle in the Jigsaw lessons.




Why this?
